

## Woodbridge School School Chapel

### Policy statement

As a Church of England Foundation School, Woodbridge School will provide an opportunity for every pupil to attend an act of worship in the School Chapel.

### Procedure

Every Year Group will attend a chapel service at least once a week during term time. The School Chaplain will usually lead these services.

- (a) Housemistress/Housemaster and Senior Master and Tutors are responsible for supervising the smooth running of the Service.
- (b) Pupils arrive promptly from their lesson and sit in rows as directed by the Prefects/ Housemistress/Housemaster. Tutors sit with their tutees.
- (c) Pupils must sit in silence before the service.
- (d) At the end of the service pupils will leave as directed by the Prefects/ Housemistress/Housemaster.
- (e) Prefects will ensure that the candles are put out and lights are turned off.
