1 Policy statement

Woodbridge School believes that wearing the correct School uniform promotes a strong, cohesive, School identity that supports high standards and a sense of identity and pride among pupils.

2 Procedure

- A uniform list is given to each new pupil who joins the School and items are available from the School Shop (apart from Sixth Form uniform).
- Staff are asked to check on a daily basis that their tutees are correctly dressed.
- Parents are encouraged to make sure that their children are correctly dressed for school and that their uniform is clean and in good condition.
- If a pupil regularly fails to adhere to the School rules, the tutor is asked to contact the parents. If the pupil continues to fail to adhere to School rules the Housemaster / Housemistress is informed and if the pupil still fails to comply with the dress regulations, they run the risk of being sent home by the Headmaster.
- If a pupil's dress or hair is deemed totally inappropriate, they may be sent home at the discretion of the Headmaster or his nominated deputy.
- Pupils are recognisable as being part of the School, irrespective of time, when they are wearing their uniform, and must therefore make sure that they are always dressed smartly and behave accordingly. Eating and drinking in the streets whilst wearing the School uniform is not allowed.
