

## Woodbridge School Sporting Colours, Honours and Awards

### Policy

In order to recognise the achievements and efforts of pupils from Woodbridge School in the realms of Sport a system of Sports Colours, Honours and Awards is followed.

### Procedure

- ❑ Colours policy to run through from Year 7 – Year 13, with awards remaining the same.

❑ <b>Half Colours</b> – for eligibility, pupils must attend at least 90% of the games and practices and be a key member of the side
❑ <b>Colours (Sports Specific)</b> – for eligibility, pupil must play at around county level and would play in the majority of sides played.
❑ <b>Honours (Sport Specific)</b> – playing at or around national level in sport.

- ❑ **Major stipulation (to be consistently applied throughout all 3 levels of award.)**
- ❑ “to be eligible for an award , the team member must conduct themselves in accordance with both the spirit and roles of their specific sport. In addition they must conduct themselves in a manner befitting of the ethos’ of Woodbridge School.”
- ❑ In addition to the above statement, if at any time a disciplinary issue arises, the team member in question may forfeit their rights to any awards (Adjudication by AGL/NLS/RJT)
- ❑ **HALF COLOURS / COLOURS / HONOURS MEETING**
  - Before the conferral of any of the above awards, a meeting shall take place with the Heads of each specific sport, namely AGL, NLS, RJT, DAB, (MRF Tennis term)
  - Colours are awarded via a process of majority voting with the power of veto enabled. Nominees shall be forwarded by the respective sports whereupon each candidate will be discussed before a vote is undertaken. Personal recommendations may be accepted by AGL/NLS/RJT from those coaches not in attendance. All years are involved in this procedure, but preferably Years 8, 10, and senior levels.
  - Honours to be forwarded at the colours meeting. AGL/NLS/RJT to consult Headmaster for final decision regarding the award of Honours. Honours to be awarded at any year from yr7 – 13, but only senior pupils will be added to the honours board.

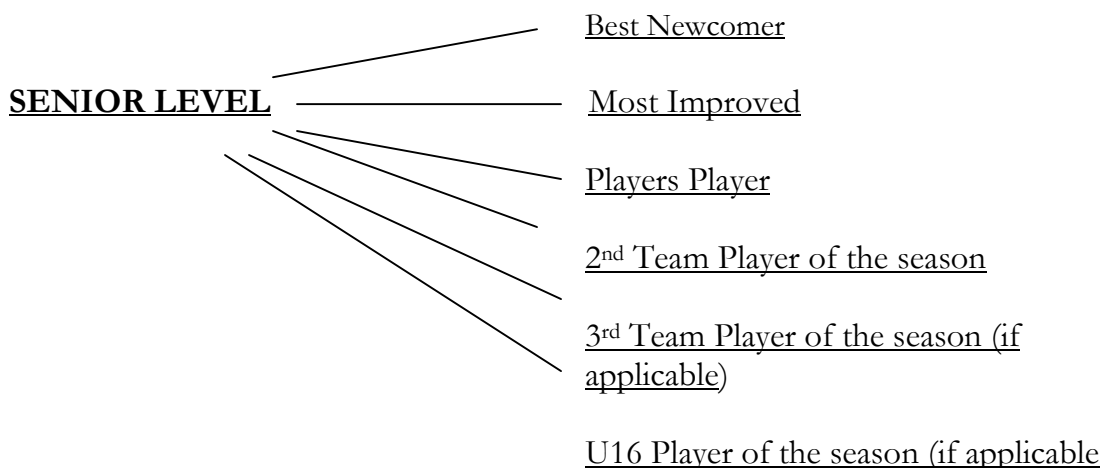
