

Woodbridge School SARS

1 Policy Statement

To ensure that all pupils are protected from the dangers of SARS.

2 Procedure

- Pupils who visit a SARS affected area (as defined by the World Health Organisation) will not be allowed to return to School until they have been back in the UK for ten days.
- Such pupils are expected to return to the UK ten days before term starts and the responsibility for these arrangements rests with the parents. Boarders must have passport stamps checked by their Housemaster/Mistress and will be asked to leave the premises if inside the restricted time limit.
- On their return boarders will be monitored by the School Doctor for any signs of illness.
- School staff are discouraged from taking holidays that involve visiting or passing through SARS affected areas. If they do, they should return ten days before term starts and should not visit the School during this time.
- Existing or prospective parents from SARS affected areas are asked not to visit the School until they have been in the UK for ten days.
