

Woodbridge School SCHOOL CHAPEL

1 Policy Statement

As a Church of England Foundation School, Woodbridge School will provide an opportunity for every pupil to attend an act of worship in the School Chapel.

2 Procedure

Every pupil, unless unavoidably required for a specific alternative activity (such activities to be kept to an absolute minimum, and permission for them sought from the Headmaster) will attend a weekly Chapel service during term time. The School Chaplain will usually lead these services. Services are for Year 7 separately, Years 8 and 9 together, Years 10 and 11, and Years 12 and 13.

- Housemaster/Mistress, tutors, SMT, and Prefects are variously responsible for supervising the smooth running of the service.
- Pupils arrive promptly from their lesson and sit in rows as directed.
- Pupils must sit in silence before the service.
- At the end of the service pupils will leave under direction.
- The Chaplain or prefects will ensure that the candles are put out and lights are turned off.
