BURSARY SELECTION CRITERIA

The award of bursaries is on the recommendation of the Headmaster. The total number of bursaries given, and their value, is at the discretion of the Governors and delegated to the Bursar.

The selection of pupils for recommendation is decided by the Headmaster in discussion with the Director of Studies, and other appropriate senior staff.

Bursaries are competitive and pupils will be ranked on the following criteria:

- Excellent performance in the appropriate entrance examination
- Potential to benefit from the key strengths of the School in music; sport; drama
- Need to benefit from the School's exceptional pastoral care
- Commitment to the School's Christian ethos
